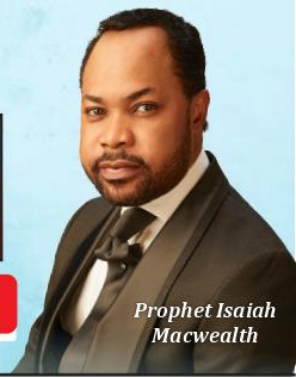

ARSENAL 20: PRAYER FOR PERSONAL REVIVAL



Prophet Isaiah

1. *For thus saith the Lord to the men of Judah and Jerusalem, Break up your fallow ground, and sow not among thorns. Circumcise yourselves to the Lord, and take away the foreskins of your heart, ye men of Judah and inhabitants of Jerusalem: lest my fury come forth like fire, and burn that none can quench it, because of the evil of your doings. - Jeremiah 4: 3-4*

Circumcise my heart oh Lord, take away the foreskin thereof, break up the fallow places that I sow not among the thorns.

2. *And they said one to another, did not our heart burn within us, while he talked with us by the way, and while he opened to us the scriptures? - Luke 24: 32*

Let my heart burn again at every opening of your word, wrap up your fire within me, let me revive with more passion for you and your kingdom.

3. *Sow to yourselves in righteousness, reap in mercy; break up your fallow ground: for it is time to seek the LORD, till he come and rain righteousness upon you. - Hosea 10:12*

When thou saidst, seek ye my face; my heart said unto thee, thy face, LORD, will I seek. - Psalm 27:8

Cause me to seek thy face oh Lord, with all my heart. Break up the hardness in my heart that I may desire you more and more.

4. *“And God said unto him in a dream, Yea, I know that thou didst this in the integrity of thy heart; for I also withheld thee from sinning against me: therefore, suffered I thee not to touch her. - Genesis 20:6*

And when Abram was ninety years old and nine, the LORD appeared to Abram, and said unto him, I am the Almighty God; walk before me, and be thou perfect. - Genesis 17: 1

Withhold me oh Lord from sinning against you, cause my ways to be perfect in your sight.

5. *Keep thy tongue from evil, and thy lips from speaking guile. - Psalm 34:13*

Oh Lord my God, keep my tongue from evil and my lips from speaking guile

6. *Let the words of my mouth, and the meditation of my heart, be acceptable in thy sight, O LORD, my strength, and my redeemer. - Psalm 19:14*

Place a guard on my lips and on my heart that the words of my mouth and the meditations of my heart may always please thee oh Lord.

7. *Order my steps in thy word: and let not any iniquity have dominion over me. - Psalm 119:133*

Order my every step oh Lord, that iniquity may not have dominion over me.

8. *For sin shall not have dominion over you: for ye are not under the law, but under grace.* - **Romans 6:14**
Father in the name of Jesus, we pray, let Your Grace for Holiness be at work in me that sin may not have dominion over me.
9. *Examine me, O LORD, and prove me; try my reins and my heart.* - **Psalm 26:2**
Oh Lord, try my heart, examine my ways and prove me before Your Presence this day.
10. *Teach me thy way, O LORD; I will walk in thy truth: unite my heart to fear thy name.* - **Psalm 86: 11**
Oh Lord my God, teach me your ways that I may walk in Your truth, give me an undivided heart, that I may fear Your Name.
11. *And whatsoever ye do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God and the Father by him.* - **Colossians 3:17**
Father in the name of Jesus I pray, help me to be consistent in character, that whatever I do or say, my actions, my words, will represent You Lord Jesus.
12. *I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.* - **Romans 12:1**
Father in the name of Jesus, by Your mercies oh Lord, give me the grace to give my body as a living and holy sacrifice. The kind of sacrifice that is acceptable to You Lord as this is my true worship.
13. *But when he was strong, his heart was lifted up to his destruction: for he transgressed against the LORD his God and went into the temple of the LORD to burn incense upon the altar of incense.* - **2 Chronicles 26:16**
Oh Lord my God, I pray, do not let my heart be lifted up to destruction by trusting in my strength, in my ability, and in my riches thereby forgetting You who is the author of it.
14. *Wherefore, my beloved, as ye have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling.* - **Philippians 2:12**
Father in the name of Jesus, by your mercies and your grace, help me to work hard to show the results of my salvation with reverence and fear.
15. *Blessed are the pure in heart: for they shall see God.* - **Matthew 5:8**
Oh Lord God of all righteousness, grant unto me I pray a pure heart, a heart like yours, filled with compassion, love, faith, and free from evil thoughts and wickedness.

16. *Turn us, O God of our salvation, and cause thine anger toward us to cease. Wilt thou be angry with us forever? wilt thou draw out thine anger to all generations? Wilt thou not revive us again: that thy people may rejoice in thee?* - **Psalm 85:4-6**

Turn your anger from me, revive me that I may rejoice in thee, turn me away from your anger.

17. *For thus saith the high and lofty One that inhabiteth eternity, whose name is Holy; I dwell in the high and holy place, with him also that is of a contrite and humble spirit, to revive the spirit of the humble, and to revive the heart of the contrite ones.* - **Isaiah 57:15**

The LORD is nigh unto them that are of a broken heart; and saveth such as be of a contrite spirit. *Psalm 34:18*

The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit: a broken and a contrite heart, O God, thou wilt not despise. - **Psalm 51:17**

Give me oh Lord, a contrite and a humble spirit, revive my heart that I may dwell with you in the high and holy place.

18. *They that dwell under his shadow shall return; they shall revive as the corn and grow as the vine: the scent thereof shall be as the wine of Lebanon.* - **Hosea 14:7**

Let me dwell under your shadow that I may revive as the corn and grow as the vine.

19. *But when he was strong, his heart was lifted up to his destruction: for he transgressed against the LORD his God and went into the temple of the LORD to burn incense upon the altar of incense.* - **2 Chronicles 26:16**

Lift not my heart, oh Lord to destruction, but let me compass your altar with meekness.
