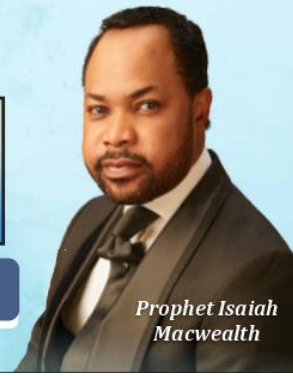

ARSENAL 22: PRAYER FOR JERUSALEM

1. *Having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will, - Ephesians 1:5*

Father in the name of Jesus, we thank you for adopting us into the lineage of your son Jesus through the sacrifice paid on the cross for both the Gentiles and the Jews in Jesus name.

2. *But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a peculiar people, that you should show forth the praises of him, who hath called you out of darkness into his marvelous light - 1 Peter 2:9*

Thank you, father, for your chosen generation, the Jews and the gentiles being partakers, we have been aligned into the same inheritance in the Abrahamic covenant.

3. *Pray for the peace of Jerusalem, they shall prosper that love thee - Psalm 122:6*

Father, we ask for peace in the city of Jerusalem, may peace be within their walls in Jesus name.

4. *Peace be within thy walls and prosperity within thy palaces - Psalm 122:7*

Father we ask for the prosperity of Jerusalem within their palaces for the sake of our brothers and friends in the nation.

5. *Because of the house of the lord our God, I will seek thy good - Psalm 122:9*

Father, we seek the good of Jerusalem for the sake of the Lords house that we might be blessed that favor Zion.

6. *Who hath believed our report? And to whom is the arm of the Lord revealed? - Isaiah 53:1*

My Father and My God, we ask that the confusion between both tribes and clans in Jerusalem be resolved by the truth being revealed to them in Jesus Name.

7. *That we should be to the praise of his glory who first trusted in Christ. - Ephesians 1:12*

Oh Lord, open the eyes of their understanding that they might know the hope of their calling to the nations.

8. *Now thanks be unto God, which always causeth us to triumph in Christ, and maketh manifest the savour of his knowledge by us in every place. - 2 Corinthians 2:14*

Oh Lord My God, we ask that you remove the veil that has covered the eyes of Israel, that they would recognize their Yeshua as their Messiah

9. *Thou shalt arise and mercy upon Zion, for the time to favor her, ye the set time hath come - Psalm 102:13*

My Father, My God, show your mercy and favor in this set time to Israel, let your mercy not depart from Israel.

10. *Hear the word of the Lord, oh ye nations and declare it in the aisles afar off and say, he that scattereth Israel will gather him and keep him as a shepherd doth his flock. - Jeremiah 31:10*

According to Jeremiah 31:10, father we ask that you continue to draw the people in Jerusalem closer to you according to your sovereign plan.

11. *For the Rod of the wicked shall not rest upon the lot of the righteous, lest the righteous put forth their hand unto iniquity - Psalm 125:3*

Father in the name of Jesus, we pray that the scepter of the wicked will not remain over the land allotted for the righteous. Father break the strongholds of religion, pride and wickedness that seek to control Israel.

12. *And give him no rest till he establishes and till he makes Jerusalem a praise in the earth. - Isaiah 62:7*

Oh Lord our God, give their oppressors no rest, till you establish Jerusalem and make her a praise amongst the nations of the earth.

13. *And they shall call them, the Holy people, the redeemed of the Lord and thou shalt be called, sought out, a city not forsaken. - Isaiah 62:12*

Oh Lord by your mercy, forsake not Jerusalem, and remember your promise in Isaiah 62:12, the redeemed of the Lord, a people sought after by many, a city not forsaken.

14. *For the Lord will not forsake his people, for his great name sake because it hath pleased the Lord to make you his people - 1 Samuel 12:22*

My Father, My Maker you have promised that you will not forsake your people Israel, for your great name sake because it has pleased the Lord to make Israel his people. Use us to help others understand your plan for Israel and your love for the Jewish people.

15. *The Lord bringeth the counsel of the heathen to nought: he maketh the devices of the people of none effect - Psalm 33:10*

Father in the name of Jesus, because you bring the counsel of nations to nothing and make their plans to no effect, according to Psalm 33:10, we declare that Gods purposes for Israel will be completely fulfilled and you will be glorified.

16. *For the mountains shall depart and the hills be removed but my kindness shall not depart from thee neither shall the covenant of my peace be removed, saith the Lord that hath mercy on thee - Isaiah 54:10*

Oh Lord, you are the covenant keeping God, we pray that you will remember your covenants and promises towards Israel; especially when others rise up to swallow her alive; when their wrath is kindled against her; as waters will not overwhelm her; God will not give her as a prey to their teeth.

17. *For I would not, brethren, that ye should be ignorant of this mystery, lest ye should be wise in your own conceits, that blindness in part is happened to Israel until the fullness of the gentiles be come in and so all Israel be saved as it is written “ there shall come out of Zion the deliverer and shall turn away ungodliness away from Jacob. - Romans 11:25-26*

Father in the name of Jesus, cause the churches in Jerusalem to fulfil its commission to preach the gospel to the whole world, so that the full number of the gentiles will come into the kingdom, thereby making all of Israel to be saved.

18. *And I will bless them that bless thee and curse him that curseth thee and in thee shall all families of the earth be blessed. - Genesis 12:3*

Father, we bless those that bless Jerusalem and curse those that curse them in Jesus name.

19. *For he is our peace, who hath made both one and hath broken down the middle wall of partition between us. - Ephesians 2:14*

Father, we bring down the dividing walls between the Jews and the gentiles that they might become one, destroying the barrier and dividing walls of hostility in Jesus Name.

20. *And for me, that utterance may be given unto me, that I may open my mouth boldly to make known the mystery of the gospel. - Ephesians 6:19*

Oh Lord, My God, open the door for our missionaries to enter into Jerusalem, give us men that will speak boldly the mystery of the gospel of truth that many might be saved.
