## ARSENAL 26: PRAYER FOR THE PROPHET

*For even hereunto were ye called: because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that ye should follow his steps - 1Peter 2:21*

**1. Father in the name of Jesus, we pray that our man of God will walk closely with Jesus and the saints of old.**

*Jesus saith unto them, My meat is to do the will of him that sent me, and to finish his work. - John 4:34*

**2. Father in the name of Jesus, we pray that our prophet will fulfill Gods plan and purpose for his life.**

*In the body of his flesh through death, to present you holy and unblameable and unreprouceable in his sight: - Colossians 1:22*

**3. Father in the name of Jesus, we pray that our prophet will be without blemish to present his ministry without blemish.**

*Surely the Lord God will do nothing, but he revealeth his secret unto his servants the prophets. - Amos 3:7*

**4. Father in the name of Jesus , We pray that our man of God will partake of heavenly strategy.**

*And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them. - Acts 2:3*

**5. Father in the name of Jesus , We pray that the fire of God will sit mightily on our prophet's head.**

*And hope maketh not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us. - Romans 5:5*

**6. Father in the name of Jesus, we Pray that the love of Christ will sit in the heart of our prophet.**

*He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water. - John 7:38*

**7. Father in the name of Jesus, we pray that the spirit of prayer will sit in his belly.**

*That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him: The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints, And what is the exceeding greatness of his power to us-ward who believe, according to the working of his mighty power -*

**Ephesians 1:17-19**

**8. Father in the name of Jesus , We pray that the father of Glory will give unto him the spirit of wisdom and revelation.**

**9. Father in the name of Jesus , We pray that the eyes of his understanding will be enlightened**

**10. We pray that he will know the hope of his calling and the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints.**

**11. We pray that he will understand the exceeding greatness of his power even as he believes.**

*That he would grant you, according to the riches of his glory, to be strengthened with might by his Spirit in the inner man; - Ephesians 3:16*

**12. We pray that our prophet will be strengthened with might in his inner man**

*For this cause we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to desire that ye might be filled with the knowledge of his will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; - Colossians 1:9*

**13. We pray that he will be filled with the knowledge of his will, in all wisdom and spiritual understanding**

*And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fulness of God. - Ephesians 3:19*

**14. We pray that the man of God will know the love of Christ that passeth knowledge that he might be filled with the fullness of God.**

*And now, Lord, behold their threatenings: and grant unto thy servants, that with all boldness they may speak thy word, By stretching forth thine hand to heal; and that signs and wonders may be done by the name of thy holy child Jesus. - Acts 4:29-30*

**15. We pray that God will grant unto our prophet boldness to speak the word of God and that by the stretching forth of his hands, healing, signs and wonders may be done in the name of Jesus.**

*And for me, that utterance may be given unto me, that I may open my mouth boldly, to make known the mystery of the Gospel, - Ephesians 6:19*

**16. We pray that as our prophet opens his mouth, words may be given to him to fearlessly make known the mystery of the gospel.**

*And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power: - 1Corinthians 2:4*

**17. We pray that our prophet's speech and preaching will not be in enticing words of man's wisdom but in the demonstration of the spirit and of power.**

*For I will give you a mouth and wisdom, which all your adversaries shall not be able to gainsay nor resist. - Luke 21:15*

**18. We pray that the Lord will give our prophet a mouth and a wisdom that his enemies cannot gainsay or resist.**

*That ye may approve things that are excellent; that ye may be sincere and without offence till the day of Christ. Being filled with the fruits of righteousness, which are by Jesus Christ, unto the glory and praise of God. - Philippians 11:10-11*

**19. We pray that our man of God will approve only things that are excellent, that he will walk worthy of the Lord unto all pleasing, being filled with the fruits of righteousness and will be sincere and without offence until the day of Christ.**

*That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works. - 2 Timothy 3:17*

**20. We pray that our prophet will be perfect and thoroughly furnished unto every good work.**

*That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works. - 2 Timothy 4:5*

*Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust. - 2 Peter 1:4*

**21. We pray that he will make full proof of his ministry and give diligence to make his calling and election sure.**
